Family Domestic Violence Training Calendar

The Family Violence Provisions (FVP) in Immigration Law

This one day training is vital for community workers and volunteers who provide support for migrant women experiencing family violence perpetrated by a sponsoring partner. Participants will learn how the FVP operates, its impact on migrant women, eligibility criteria, how to provide effective evidence, support services and how workers can better assist the application process.

Date for FVP training

Cross Cultural Domestic Violence Training (CCDV)

This one day training will explore the multitude of issues and barriers confronting migrant and refugee women of non-English speaking background (NESB) in experiencing and escaping domestic violence, and accessing services. The training will also look at the impact of immigration issues as well as strategies for improving access to services for NESB women.
